



## Core Classes

### **\*Pre-Algebra Readiness**

**(June 5-29. 8:00-12:00, M-TH) \$355**

This class is designed for students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grader that need to prepare for pre-algebra. This course will focus on: fractions, decimals, percents, and basic operations.

### **\*Pre-Algebra 6-7**

**(June 5-29. 1:00-4:00, M-TH) \$355**

This class is designed for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade and for students who had difficulty in or who failed 6<sup>th</sup> grade math. This course will focus on operations with integers and other rational numbers. Students will also learn to solve algebraic equations and will work with unknowns to solve various other problems.

### **\*Pre-Algebra 7-8**

**(June 5-29. 8:00-12:00, M-TH) \$355**

This class is designed for students entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade and for students who had difficulty in or who failed 7<sup>th</sup> grade math. This course will review and master operations with Real Numbers. Students will also use algebraic language to solve equations and represent unknown quantities.

### **\*Algebra I (9<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Grade Review)**

**(June 5-29. 8:00-12:00, M-TH) \$355**

This class is designed for students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade and for students who had difficulty in or who failed 8<sup>th</sup> grade math. It is a review course of basic algebra that is designed to improve skills in solving equations, graphing, factoring polynomials, and simplifying algebraic expressions.

### **\*Intro to Latin**

**(June 5-29. 8:00-12:30, M-F) \$345**

This class is designed for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade and for students who had difficulty in or who failed 6<sup>th</sup> grade Latin. This 1<sup>st</sup> year course will prepare students for 7<sup>th</sup> grade Latin I.

### **\*6<sup>th</sup> Grade English Readiness**

**(June 5-29. 8:00-12:00, M-TH) \$225**

This class is designed for students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade that need to prepare for 6<sup>th</sup> grade Lit/Comp. This class will focus on the areas of reading, writing, and grammar skills.

### **\*English 6-7**

**(June 5-June 29. 8:00-12:00, M-TH) \$225**

This class is designed for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade and for students who had difficulty in or who failed 6<sup>th</sup> grade Lit/Comp. This class will focus on higher levels of reading, writing, and grammar.

### **\*Comp Camp**

**(June 5-29. 1:00-4:00, M-TH) \$355**

This class is designed for students who had difficulty in or who failed 8<sup>th</sup> grade Lit/Comp. It is a four week intensive course designed to help students who require more work on reading, analyzing, and writing essays.

### **\*High School Writing Workshop**

**(June 5-16, 9-11, M-F) \$150**

This course is meant for high school students who would like to brush up on their writing skills. We will study the three elements of writing stressed in Humane Letters classes at Arete: invention, organization, and style. We will practice these elements by applying them to our own nonfiction and fiction pieces.

## **Supplemental Classes**

### **\*6<sup>th</sup> Grade Study Skills Course**

**(June 5-9. 1:00-2:30, M/W/F) \$100**

This course is designed to teach incoming 6<sup>th</sup> grade middle school students valuable skills to increase productivity and preparedness, as well as to set goals and balance their academic lives. The class will focus on: student life, preparation and procrastination, efficiency, active learning, and test preparation.

### **\*Typing Skills+**

**(June 6-June 10, June 13-17, June 20 – June 24, June 27- July 1. 1:00-3:00, M-TH) \$100 (Computers provided)**

In this age of technology, computer skills are essential both in academia and industry. This one-week course is designed to give an introduction to touch typing and word processing. We will also go over basic MLA formatting, which is the standard format for papers at Great Hearts Academies.

### **\*Art Portfolio Preparedness**

**(June 5-16. 1-3:00, M-TH) \$100**

### **\*Yearbook Design Workshop**

### **\*Drama Camp**
