



2019 Summer School Course Descriptions

June 3- 27

Pre-Algebra/Intermediate Algebra – Mr. Alvarez – 8-11am – Monday through Thursday – \$350

- What it Covers: Computational and number sense skills of calculation necessary for the completion of Pre-Algebra and Intermediate Algebra. This course will be differentiated to suit the needs of each student.
- Who it's For: incoming 7th graders who did not pass Pre-algebra or incoming 8th graders who did not pass Intermediate Algebra

Algebra I – Mr. Alvarez – 12-3pm – Monday through Thursday – \$350

- What it Covers: Methods of algebraic thinking that the process and practice of the Exeter Curriculum. This course satisfies the AZ state credit requirement for Algebra I.
- Who it's For: Incoming 9th and 10th graders who do not have an Algebra credit, incoming 9th graders who did not pass Algebra I

Lit Comp – Grade 6/7 – Mr. Esparza – 12-3pm – Monday through Thursday– \$350

- What it Covers: Basic skills of reading, writing, speaking, and grammar analysis
- Who it's For: Incoming 6th graders who need extra lit/comp support, incoming 7th graders who did not pass 6th grade Lit/comp, and incoming 8th graders who did not pass 7th grade Lit/comp

Comp Camp – Mr. Esparza – 8-11am – Monday through Thursday– \$350

- What it Covers: Advanced middle school skills of reading, writing, and speaking, with a focus on the writing Curriculum at Arete
- Who it's For: incoming 8th graders who did not pass 8th grade Lit/comp, incoming 9th and 10th graders who need extra writing support and new 9th and 10th graders

Latin I – Mr. Loving – 12-3pm – Monday through Thursday– \$350

- What it Covers: Preliminary skills needed to learn Latin, vocabulary, and declensions
- Who it's For: incoming 7th grade students who did not pass 6th grade Latin and new 7th and 8th graders

Latin II – Ms. Carnahan – 8-11am – Monday through Thursday– \$350

- What it Covers: Advanced middle school skills needed for Latin, including translation
- Who it's For: incoming 8th graders who did not pass 7th grade Latin

Advanced Comp Camp – Mr. Marasinghe – 8-11am – Tuesday and Wednesday only – \$180

- What it Covers: Skills and practices needed to write the Senior Thesis.
- Who it's For: Selected students from the class of 2020 (By recommendation through Mr. Marasinghe).
